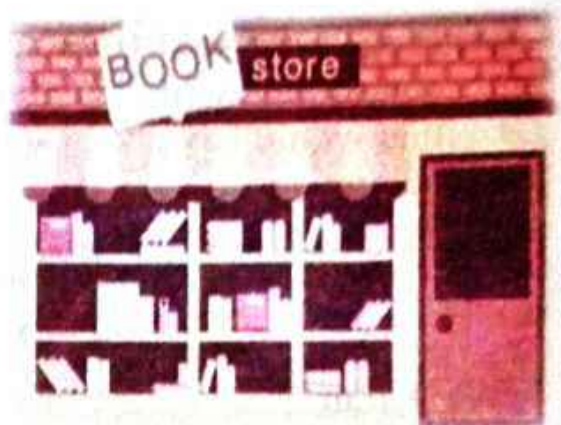
(c) To which country is the least number of *rakhis* being sent?
